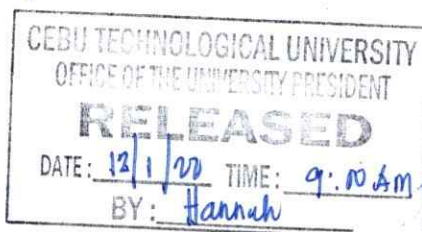

**SUBJECT:** PARTICIPATION IN THE LOCAL YOUTH WORKER MOBILITY TRAINING COURSE

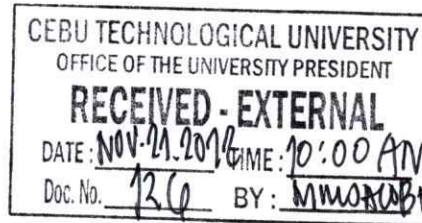
